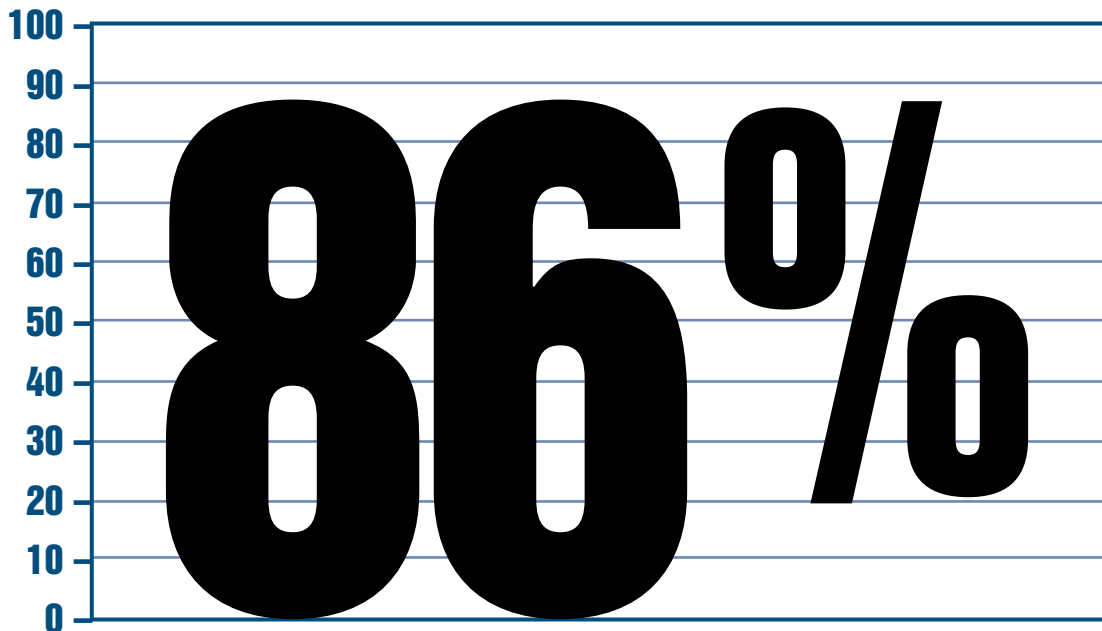

The John Shaw Award is presented by Maryland Business for Responsive Government to members of the Maryland General Assembly whose voting records reflect their support of MBRG's efforts to improve Maryland's business climate.

Maryland legislators with a cumulative MBRG score of 70 percent or above (and a minimum four years service) deserve recognition. Experience shows that states with a minimum average pro business score of 70 percent for *all* legislators are the winners in the interstate competition for the jobs and capital that stimulate economic development.

John Shaw was an exemplary citizen/legislator. A man of many talents, he was a cabinetmaker of the highest standing who also designed the flag with the distinctive eight-point star that flew over the Annapolis Statehouse more than 200 years ago when Annapolis was America's capital, a high point in Maryland's history.
